STEPHANIE A. PAULSELL TO DELIVER E. GLENN HINSON LECTURES ON MARCH 7, 2011

Dr. Paulsell's lectures will explore the Song of Songs as a resource for contemporary Christian spirituality that is attentive to the goodness of the body, cultivates a posture of devotion towards the world and others, and seeks intimacy with God. She will address the question: Can this once important devotional text for Christians be recovered as a devotional text in our day without a wholesale return to allegorical methods of interpretation?

Dr. Stephanie Paulsell is the Amory Houghton Professor of the Practice of Ministry Studies at Harvard Divinity School. She is the author of *Honoring the Body: Meditations on a Christian Practice* and editor of *The Scope of Our Art: The Vocation of the Theological Teacher*.

She received a Ph.D. in Religion and Literature from the University of Chicago in 1993 and

has taught at the University of Chicago Divinity School, Catholic Theological Union and Valparaiso University. She is an ordained minister in the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) and lives with her husband and daughter in Cambridge, Massachusetts.

A special feature of this year's lectureship will be a presentation of memoirs by Dr. Hinson (see below).

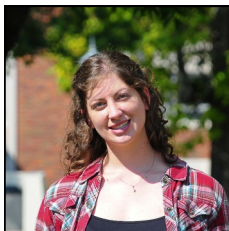


Sara Clarke

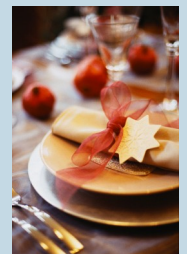
