### **ELIGIBILITY**

Applicants for admission to the Master of Divinity Program of Baptist Seminary of Kentucky are required to:

- have a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in the United States or proof of an equivalent degree from a foreign university,
- have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 overall and 3.0 in your major is normally required.

Persons who do not currently possess the pre-requisite qualifications for admission or who do not intend to pursue vocational ministry may audit courses, but must supply the same documents mentioned above. Admission will be based on a total profile including the student's undergraduate GPA, personal information, letters of recommendation, and an interview.

### **DEADLINE:**

Applications should be in by June 1st for fall enrollment and by December 1st for spring and January enrollment. Summer enrollment deadline is May 1st.
